The minimum level of service has been met; therefore, we are submitting our monthly report and invoice based on tag sale receipts determined by the Department of Highway Safety and verified by DEO Finance and Accounting. The following is a summary of accomplishments for the month of May:

Florida Sports Foundation's professional sports tag sales revenue use:

Professional Sports Development Trust Fund: Tag revenue due for May: \$224,687.00. Total Pro-Team Tag Net Revenue for this fiscal year-to-date is \$2,594,010.90.

Grant Programs, Section 320.08058(9)(b)(1):

Grant Program activity through May: Sixteen 4th Quarter grant applications were received by the April 10th deadline. A Grant Committee meeting was held on May 1st to review the applications. The Committee recommendations were presented to and awarded as presented by the FS Board of Directors on May 23rd in Jacksonville. Grant Program awards: 16 fourth-quarter grants were awarded \$543,860, and are projected to bring an out-of-state economic impact of \$190,207,668 and 156,485 visitors.

Florida-based charities pursuant to Section 320.08058(9)(b)(2), FL Statutes Florida's Nine Professional Sports Teams Tag Charity Payments: The charity amount accrued and paid for the first three fiscal quarters: \$234,377.71. The charity amount for this quarter-to-date: \$47,580, to be paid out in July. Total accrued this fiscal year-to-date: \$281,957.71.

Sunshine State Games (SSG) & Florida Senior Games (FSG):

In May: Staff attended the Spring Festival Events: Figure Skating (Pasco County), Basketball, (Alachua County) and Lacrosse, (Broward County), and the Florida Sports Summit in Jacksonville.
