The minimum level of service has been met; therefore, we are submitting our monthly report and invoice based on tag sale receipts determined by the Department of Highway Safety and verified by DEO Finance and Accounting. The following is a summary of accomplishments for the month of October:

Florida Sports Foundation's professional sports tag sales revenue use:

Professional Sports Development Trust Fund: Tag revenue due for October: \$237,061.00. Total Pro-Team Tag Net Revenue for this fiscal year-to-date is \$1,028,789.12.

Grant Programs, Section 320.08058(9)(b)(1)

FY2018/19 Grant Program Awards: 40 first-quarter grants were awarded \$495,466, (as one has since been cancelled), and 2 major event grants that will take place in 2021 were awarded \$2,600,000 with separate future fiscal year payment contracts. This year's contracted amount for the two major events is \$250,000 each. The 42 awarded grants are projected to bring an adjusted out-of-state economic impact of \$268,540,671 and 175,608 out-of-state visitors. 42 Grant applications were received by the October deadline. A Grant Committee meeting was held on October 29th, and 41 applications were approved to submit to the Foundation's Board of Directors on December 13 in Sarasota.

Total accrued this fiscal-year-to-date: \$111,824.90.

In October: Staff held Sunshine State Games shooting events in multiple counties. Staff is finalizing the Senior Games event to be held in Clearwater in December. Staff held meetings in regards to venues, upcoming events, conferences and promotions.
